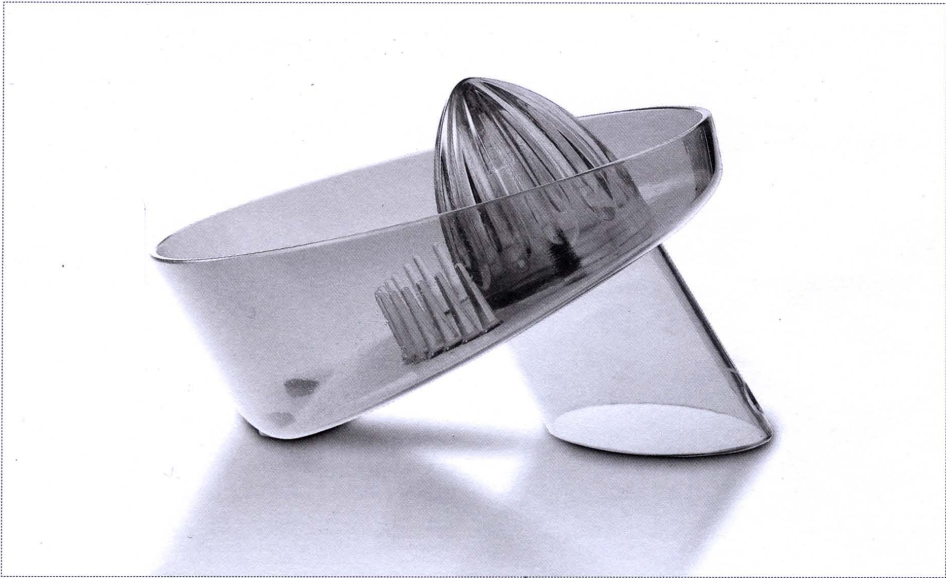
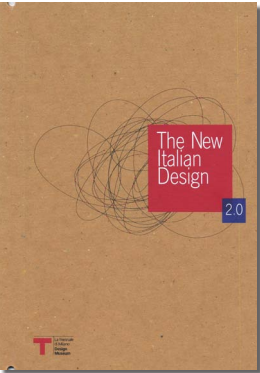




011 CITRUS SQUEEZER, LATINA SERIES | 2004 | FRATELLI GUZZINI

It is a mono-moulded injection citrus squeezer made with plastic material (SAN), resulting from a rigorous formal synthesis: the inclination allows obtaining in only one piece the drainage of the pulp from the juice of the citrus fruit.

Lorenzo Gecchelin was born in Milan in 1971, where he lives and works, and where he graduated in architecture at the Politecnico. Since 1996 he has worked as product designer in his Studio Gecchelin, designing for companies like O-Luce, iGuzzini Illuminazione, F.lli Guzzini, Aermec-Riello, Poltrona Frau, Telma Guzzini, Almini Milan, Kelvin Italy, Whirlpool Europe, Antonangeli, Ivela, Skipper and Raat. He

also produces packaging, graphic and communication design for Milan municipal council, trade event installations and refurbishment and interior design projects. He has been selected for and won prizes in many design competitions, including Premio San Carlo Borromeo, OPoS, Sony Graphic Award; he was the 2004 winner at the 20th Compasso d'Oro ADI.
